Total Buck Award Program

**To qualify-** Minimum of three daughters with linear and milk information totaling 85 points or higher. Daughters must be from at least two dams. Two must have qualifying show points. Milk, show and linear points will be awarded as per Total Doe Program  
-OR- a buck must be in an Elite Sire listing (Top 15% - any year).

**Bonus:**

Each additional daughter at 85 points from total doe calculations – 5-points

1. 1-point for every positive PTA type on the buck with a reliability of .33 or greater (14);
2. 6-points if Average Final Score on daughter = 82 with reliability of .33 or greater (6);
3. 5-points for each positive PT (M,F,P) with reliability of .33 or over (4 @ 10 = 20);
4. Buck is CH = 5-points;
5. Buck is SG = 15-points.

**GENERAL RULES**

1. All Purebred and American Saanens will be eligible for these awards;
2. Only National Saanen Breeders Association members are eligible for awards. The person submitting the records must own a buck. A NSBA member need not own progeny;
3. To be submitted with entry:
  - a) Copy of registration certificate for proof of ownership;
  - b) Photo of buck;
  - c) Any of the following to document the award: herd appraisal sheet, performance pedigree, ADGA Performance inquiry, photocopy of ADGA performance volume page, link to info on [adgagenetics.org](http://adgagenetics.org), one day test certificate, doe page, AIPL link/print, Star Milker Certificate, ADGA Progeny Performance Inquiry.
4. Entries will be accepted with milk record, linear appraisal score, and show ring wins being achieved in different years. May be awarded posthumously;
5. Entry deadline is postmarked by June 15, 2010;
6. Entry fee of \$4 per application;
7. Two awards may be given each year, Total Buck & Reserve Total Buck; the Total Buck Award Committee will select the awards;
8. A previous Total Buck may reapply in subsequent years when he achieves a higher score;
9. Results, including all qualifying bucks, will be published in the Saanen News and submitted to the United Caprine News and Dairy Goat Journal for publication.
